

I AM A CLOSE CONTACT TO A COVID-19 POSITIVE CASE

IF YOU HAVE DIFFICULTY BREATHING, SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY.

I DON'T FEEL SICK

Regardless of vaccination status, wear a well-fitting mask around other people for 10 days from exposure.

Get tested after 5 days from exposure.

Take extra precautions in the presence of people who are at higher risk for getting sick from COVID-19.

GET TESTED AND STAY HOME UNTIL YOU RECEIVE YOUR RESULTS

POSITIVE
for COVID-19:

ISOLATE:

Stay at home and away from others within the household for 5 days after symptom onset. If symptoms are getting worse, call your doctor for guidance and treatment options or dial 911.

Wearing a well-fitting mask around other people for an additional 5 days is highly encouraged.

NEGATIVE
for COVID-19

Regardless of Vaccination status, Wear a well-fitting mask around other people for 10 days from exposure.

Get tested after 5 days from exposure.

Take extra precautions in the presence of people who are at higher risk for getting sick from COVID-19.

To receive the oral treatments, you must have a current laboratory confirmed COVID-19 infection and a referral from a prescribing physician.
